
## DUSSIHAL Brooch W

This is a simple little brooch I designed in order to support the <u>PussyHat Project</u>. Enjoy!

<u>Materials:</u> the brooch can be made in any weight yarn, with its appropriate needles. The example shown uses *DK cotton*, and *2.5mm* needles. A *safety pin* will also be needed.

Size: using DK - 4x4cm (1.5x1.5")

<u>Abbreviations:</u> K - knit; K2tog - knit 2 sts together; P - purl; SKP - slip one, knit one, pass slipped st over; SK2P - slip one st, knit two sts together, pass slipped st over; stocking st - knit right side, purl wrong side.



## Instructions:

I made two flat pieces from the directions below, sewed them together, then simply slipped a safety pin through the back stitches.

• Cast on 13 sts, leaving a long tail for sewing seams later.

Rows I and 3 - KI, PI across.

Rows 2 and 4 - PI, KI across.

Rows 5 - 10 - stocking st.

Row 11 - K5; turn.

Row 12 - P5, turn.

Row 13 - SKP, KI, K2tog, turn.

Row 14 - P3. turn.

Row 15 - SK2P, cut yarn and pull through last st.

- Reattach yarn to work last 8 sts.
- K and Bind Off next 3sts,

then repeat rows 11 - 15 on last 5 sts.



- Make two sides, then sew up seams with the long tail, and weave in ends.
- Attach safety pin from inside the hat, as shown left, between stitches.

Done!
